







Artist impressions of the Osborne Park Hospital expansion have been released, offering a first look at the modern, welcoming health facility for women, newborns and families in Perth's northern suburbs.

The expansion is part of the broader New Women and Babies Hospital Project, which will deliver high-quality health care for women, newborns and families across Western Australia.

The purpose-built facilities at Osborne Park Hospital will combine midwifery-led and clinical birthing models with areas designed for reflection, celebration and care. It will provide capacity for double the number of births and will include:

- services for maternity, gynaecology and neonatology
- a new mother baby unit: providing care for women experiencing mental health illness during pregnancy and in the period immediately post-birth.
- a new family birth centre: providing a home-like environment and offer more choice for women.
- obstetrics theatres
- outpatient clinics.

The new building will sit comfortably within the existing hospital grounds and surrounding landscape, creating a calm and healing environment that connects patients, staff and families to nature.

Early works are underway at the Osborne Park Hospital expansion site, with construction starting in early 2026.
