



# New Women and Babies Hospital Project

## Osborne Park Hospital Precinct


Construction has officially commenced on site, and you may notice major changes on the northern side of the hospital. This expansion will deliver contemporary facilities for provision of women and newborn inpatient and outpatient services, new theatres, a family birth centre, and a mother and baby unit to support the mental health of new and expectant mothers.

It's all part of the New Women and Babies Hospital Project, which will expand services and choice for women, newborns and families in our community.

## What's happening on site – March 2026

It's a busy time in and around site as essential preparation activities continue. This will include:

- Site clearing and bulk earthworks
- Building dedicated car parking for the construction workforce
- Constructing a new car park for patients and visitors along Osborne Place.





## New path

Works will begin this month to construct a new footpath behind E Block. Once complete, the construction site boundary will be extended over the current footpath.

Works will include changes to existing kerbs and a courtyard at E Block, and construction of new kerb ramps.

## Site clearing update and piling commencement

Works have ramped up at the main construction site, located at the corner of Limosa Close and Osborne Place.

Bulk earthworks to clear and level the site in preparation for construction will continue this month. This follows the removal of some vegetation and demolition of existing infrastructure, including the A Block hospital waste facility following relocation of these facilities to J Block.

Following the completion of bulk earthworks, the piling mat will be constructed to facilitate the arrival of the first piling rig to site in the coming weeks. This is the first of two piling rigs to be brought to site for construction works on the hospital expansion.

## Northern car park development - Stage 1

Stage 1 works are underway for the new car park being constructed adjacent to Osborne Place near A and K Block to provide parking for patients and visitors. This includes clearing of some vegetation and bulk earthworks.

During these works, there will be a temporary closure of a pedestrian footpath from Osborne Place towards B Block (near the main entrance) to support a safe construction zone.

Directional signage will be in place to guide pedestrians.

## What to expect from upcoming works

- General construction noise and vibration during some activities, particularly piling and compaction works.
- Increased traffic and heavy vehicle movements in the area during construction.
- Traffic management, including signage and personnel, to safely assist construction teams, pedestrians, motorists and cyclists where required.
- Construction vehicles and equipment including survey equipment, compactor and hand tools (powered and non-powered).

Mitigation measures (including water carts and hoses for dust suppression) will be in place to minimise impacts where possible.

## Noise, dust and vibration

By nature, construction projects bring noise and, at times, dust and vibration. We are committed to minimising these impacts through measures implemented on site.

Before construction began, an acoustic specialist completed noise and vibration studies to determine the predicted level of impact to nearby properties. This has allowed the team to plan logistics and site layout in a way that minimises noise and vibration, where possible.

Additionally, noise, dust and vibration monitors are installed at locations across the hospital. These provide continuous, real-time monitoring. If levels reach 80 per cent of the permitted threshold, an alert is automatically triggered. The construction team are immediately notified, works are assessed and works are reviewed.
