Subject: Upcoming Works – Bentley Health Service Surgicentre Project

We write to inform you about upcoming works to deliver the new Bentley Health Service Surgicentre Project, at the Bentley Health Service on Mills Street in Bentley.

The Bentley Health Service Surgicentre Project involves designing, constructing, and commissioning a new, contemporary surgical facility at the existing Bentley Health Service. The new Surgicentre will provide elective surgery capacity to reduce patient waiting times.

Enabling works construction activities for the new Surgicentre will commence in April 2026, with contractor mobilisation, establishment of site offices and site set-up. Work will generally be conducted within the permitted construction hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Monday to Saturday.

Residents may notice an increase in the number of construction personnel and vehicles in the area and construction-related noise and dust.

Construction impacts will be managed in accordance with approved Construction Management Plans and Traffic Management Plans. These measures include adequate traffic management, public signage and the use of water carts where required to reduce any dust kick-up.

We appreciate your understanding during this period and remain committed to minimising impacts wherever possible. We are also committed to keeping the community updated during these project works. Updates and project information will be available at www.buildingfortomorrow.gov.au.
