What's happening on site

Current Works

This month, the construction team is relocating existing utility services within the hospital grounds near A Block and Osborne Place, as shown on the site map (see next page).

Planning is also underway to:

- build a dedicated car park for construction workers
- relocate site administration offices within the hospital grounds.

Upcoming Activity

From early 2026, activity will increase at the construction site on the corner of Limosa Close and Osborne Place. This will include clearing the site and removing existing asphalt to prepare for construction of the new facilities.
