Osborne Park Hospital is undergoing a major expansion as part of the New Women and Babies Hospital Project. This expansion includes maternity, gynaecology and neonatology services, birthing suites and theatres

What's happening in November?

Establishment of the construction site compound

Work continues to establish site offices and the construction site compound at the corner of Limosa Close and Osborne Place. This includes installing colorbond fencing around the compound.

A new hospital access road, with access from Limosa Close, is now open for use by:

- ambulances accessing the E Block entry
- hospital staff, patients and visitors accessing car parks other than A Block.

The hospital access road off Osborne Place, between Limosa Close and Dennis Street, remains open to patients and visitors accessing the A Block car park and the hospital's waste facility.

Work to relocate or alter existing utility services will start this month within the hospital grounds and nearby verge areas along Osborne Place and Limosa Close.

What to expect

- Construction noise from vehicles and equipment including, but not limited to, heavy vehicles and earthmoving equipment.
- Traffic management, including signage and personnel, to safely assist construction teams, pedestrians, motorists and cyclists where required.
- Mitigation measures to minimise noise, vibration and dust impacts where possible. This may include noise and vibration monitoring and water carts and hoses for dust suppression.
